## **Department Highlights**



#### **Communicable Disease**

- 1 COVID-19/Flu A/B Tests administered (-10)
  - 0% positivity for COVID-19 (-46%)
  - 0% positivity for Flu A/B (-9%)
- Top reported diseases in April 2024:
  - COVID-19: 30 (-52)
  - Chlamydia: 7 (0)
  - Hospitalized Influenza A: 4 (-5)
    - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases: 43 (-41)

#### **Prevention**

- Distributed 141 Naloxone kits (+33)
  - 3 known reversals (-2)
- 6 car seats distributed (-17)
- Safe sleep education completed with 12 families (+7)
- 13 new families provided diapers from the Heart of Ohio Diaper Bank (+8)
- 24 NEW families served at TCHD in April (+10)

#### **WIC**

- 76% show rate for April (-2%)
- 535 total appointments completed (+42)

#### **Environmental Health**

- 22 complaints investigated (+1)
  - 5 food service (-4)
  - 9 housing (+7)
  - O home sewage treatment system (-4)
  - 8 solid waste (+2)

### **Medical Clinic**


- Charges in April \$73,011 (12 month average \$74,217)
- Payments in April \$30,574 (12 month average \$39,511)
- Largest payer Self Pay (27%)
- 18% no show rate (-2%)
- 10 new patients (39 YTD)
- Current Outstanding Balance \$85,261.76; greater than 90 days \$20,985.47
